FROM THE HEADMASTER

It was wonderful to welcome the teachers and boys back during the first Chapel service of the year on Wednesday. It has been a long break and some parents have confided that they were more than ready to say goodbye to the boys this morning. Nonetheless we are all well rested. The beginning of a new year is a time filled with enthusiasm and the responses and singing in the Chapel proved this.

We held staff development sessions on Monday and Tuesday and, amongst other presentations, we were privileged to hear talks by Gary Kirsten. Many of the parents also enjoyed a presentation on "Parenting and Sport" by Gary on Monday night and the attendance, by over 200 people for this talk, highlights how important this topic is for us all.

An overriding theme across all our talks was how important it is for teachers, parents and employers to value the person rather than looking purely at performance. This does not in any way mean that we lessen our expectation of someone, but rather that we take up a role as coach and mentor rather than adjudicator and judge. In this way longer term goals, which are far more meaningful that instant results, need to be nurtured. From the sporting perspective Gary emphasized the need for the boys to have fun. I used his cricketing analogy in my Chapel address. While it is important to "block out" and protect your wicket at higher levels of the game, it is in the having a good swing at a ball and giving it your best that the real enjoyment of batting takes place. This is how Prep Boys should approach all aspects of life. There is plenty of time to learn how to absorb pressure later. I told the boys that 2017 should be the year of taking on challenges with this attitude. Give it your best and have fun. Boys will make mistakes, they will get answers wrong, they may fail at their first attempt and that is what we, as the teachers and parents, are there for; to pick them up, dust them off and send them out again to face their school day with enthusiasm and confidence.

As I welcome you back to school for 2017, may you feel the same excitement and positive expectations that we are encouraging and that, we hope, will fill every one of our boys' school year.
