2. Sign in with either email or cell phone number (if you use your cell phone number you will receive a 6-digit pin)

Request QR codes



**STEP 4**  
The Home screen will show you are linked. Start supporting your school with your Makro shopping. You can update your preferences in "MORE".

**STEP 5**  
You can delink from a school and/or change schools at any time.

• On the 31st of December of every year all the school/parent links will be removed and parents will need to sign up again in the new school year.  
• Important note: When linked to a school, users can still earn mRewards as normal.  
• Problems linking to your school? Parents who already receive preferential prices will not be able to link to a school. If you're not sure if this applies to you, give us a call on 0860 300 999.

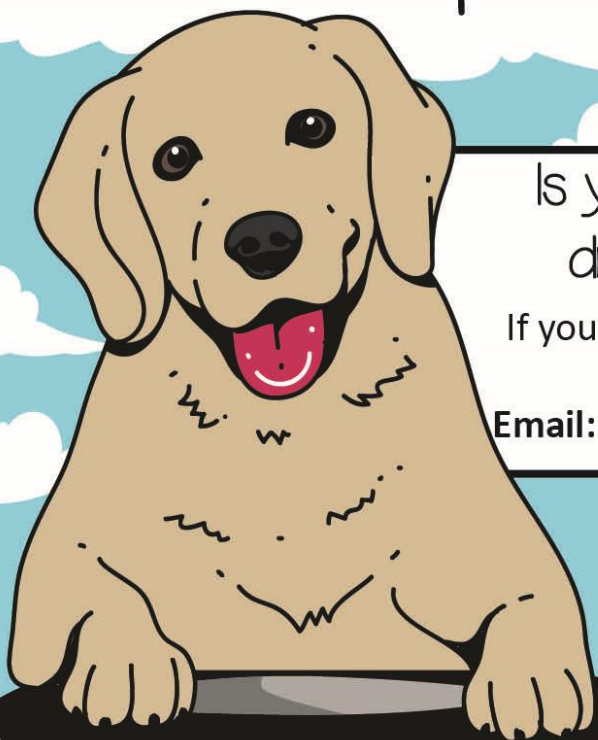
